This form must be submitted annually to NIEA by 31 January of the following year at the latest – forms submitted after this date will not be accepted and the information will not be taken into account when calculating the N loading for your farm, which may have implications for your area based scheme payment.

Please note: Under the NAP Regulations and Cross-compliance it is an offence to provide false or misleading information and penalties can apply, i.e., a fine under NAP or reduced area based scheme payments under Cross-compliance.
